

Škoda Auto Volkswagen India saw 40% rise in exports last year

Škoda Auto Volkswagen India (SAVWIPL) saw an increase in exports in the calendar year 2024, with 40 per cent of its locally manufactured vehicles shipped to over 26 countries, including key markets like North America and the ASEAN region.

This marks a 20 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) increase, reinforcing India's growing role in its global supply chain.

In 2023, exports accounted for 30 per cent of SAVWIPL's total production, with a 38 per cent Y-o-Y growth. The company shipped 44,248 units in 2023, and assuming a 20 per cent increase, it exported 53,098 units in 2024.

SAVWIPL has also expanded its global operations by exporting parts and components to Vietnam.
