+ Bajaj Auto sued over 'Freedom' trademark

SG Corporate Mobility Pvt Ltd has sued Bajaj Auto for the unauthorised use of the 'Freedom' trademark.

Bajaj Auto is using the 'Freedom' trademark for India's first CNG motorbikes. Bajaj introduced the motorbikes in July.

The company stated that in 2002, LML launched its motorbikes with the trademark 'Freedom', which was a massive success in the Indian market and carries goodwill in the minds of the public at large.

The trademark was assigned to SG Corporate Mobility in 2021 by LML along with goodwill and reputation associated with the mark.

The lawsuit filed before the Delhi High Court against Bajaj Auto is currently pending.



"The lawsuit against Bajaj Auto underscores SG Corporate Mobility's firm stance on protecting its intellectual property rights. The com-pany's efforts are aimed at ensuring that the next generation of riders can experience the same sense of freedom and reliability that made LML Freedom a household name. The brand has ambitious plans to launch a new line of scooters and motorbikes under the historic "Freedom" label, along with the "LML" brand. As part of their efforts to relaunch these iconic names," the company said in a press release.
