## India-US forum to discuss import monitoring of PCs

India's decision to implement an import mon-

itoring system for laptops, personal computers and information technology (IT) hardware will come up for discussions when the Trade Policy Forum (TPF) — the country's bilateral platform with the US — convenes a meeting later this week.

India has earlier cited national security concerns as a rationale behind its decision, which remains a

sticking point as the US has once again sought an explanation. Last month, the US had raised questions regarding India's decision at the World Trade Organization. "The US wants to understand the need for putting in place such a system and has sought a justification behind the move. We will once again explain our stance (at the TPF meet later

this week)," a senior government official told *Business Standard*.

The US has sought clarification once again even as India cited national security concerns as a rationale behind its August 2023 decision

Indian officials have explained that the decision was taken on the grounds of national security and to ensure a trusted supply chain. India has also assured the US that it has no plans to imple-

ment such a monitoring system for other products.

In August 2023, India announced that it was planning to bring several products in the IT hardware segment under the "restricted" label.
