

TaMo sees 2% rise in global wholesales

Tata Motors reported a 2 per cent increase in global wholesales for the first quarter of financial year 2024–25 (Q1FY25), when compared to Q1FY24. The total number of units sold reached 329,847, which includes sales from Jaguar Land Rover.

The company's commercial vehicle sales, including Tata Motors and the Tata Daewoo range – a commercial vehicle manufacturer headquartered in South Korea and a wholly-owned subsidiary of Tata Motors – experienced a rise in demand. This contributed to a 6 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) increase, totalling 93,410 units. **ANJALI SINGH**
