British officials may visit India in Dec to conclude FTA talks

British officials are likely to visit India in December with the aim of concluding talks on a free trade agreement (FTA) between the two countries in about four months, two Indian government sources said, after the nations missed their initial timeline.

A trade agreement between India and Britain that aims to double bilateral trade by

2030 could not be done by late October, the initial target for concluding the talks.

India's trade ministry and Britain will soon finalise if next month's talks will be at a ministerial level or the secretary level. Both the countries are aiming to finalise the FTA by the end of March, the officials told on the condition of anonymity.
