Circular economy may create 10 mn jobs by 2050: Kant



India's circular economy could generate a market value of over \$2 trillion and create 10 million jobs by 2050, the country's G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant (pictured) said Monday.

Addressing an event in New Delhi, Kant further said the circular economy can be a driver of growth, and this transition not only promises cost savings but also positions India to capitalise on the global circular economy market. "This is a huge opportunity because, by 2050, India's circular economy could generate a market value of over \$2 trillion and create close to 10 million jobs," he said.

Currently, the size of the Indian economy is \$3.7 trillion. Noting that industrialisation and urbanisation are creating an unsustainable India, Kant said, "We need circular economy as a beacon of hope".
