Hyundai Motor India signs wage settlement

Hyundai Motor India Ltd (HMIL) and the United Union of Hyundai Employees (UUHE), the recognised union, on Wednesday announced the signing of a wage settlement agreement for the period 2024–2027.

The long-term wage settlement will be effective from April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2027.

WHAT'S AGREED UPON?

The package includes a salary increase of ₹31,000 per month, structured over a three-year period in the ratio of 55 per cent, 25 per cent, and 20 per cent.

Registered in 2011, the UUHE is the officially recognised representative body for the Hyundai Motor India Ltd workforce.

As of August 31, 2025, it represents a membership of 1,981 employees (90 per cent of technician/workmen), the official release said.
