

Ericsson ramps up production of 5G gear via Jabil's plant

Ericsson is expanding its production capabilities in India as telecom companies ramp up their 5G expansion plan.

The Swedish gearmaker supplies 4G and 5G radios, radio access networks and microwave products from its partner Jabil's plant in Pune.

“We are ramping up production of our 5G telecom equipment in Pune in a phased manner, to support the network deployments of Indian telecom service providers. The production in India is part of our global production footprint with a presence across continents. This footprint has enabled us to secure a global, flexible, and resilient supply chain,” said Nunzio Mirtillo, Ericsson's head of market for Southeast Asia, Oceania and India. **ANEESH PHADNIS**
