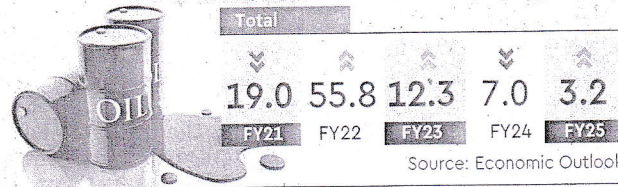
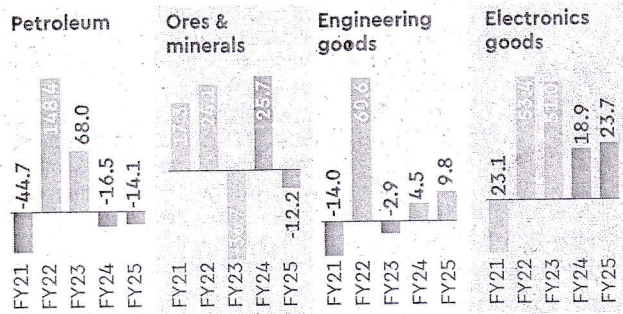


Electronics, engineering goods drive shipments

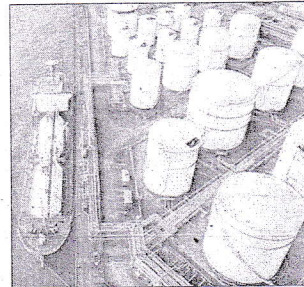
EXPORTS GROWTH April to October; % chg, y-o-y



WHILE INDIA'S GOODS exports grew 3.2% during April-October this year, shipments of electronics and engineering goods rose at much faster rates.

Exports of electronics goods grew at a faster clip of 23.7% during the seven months of this financial year as compared with 18.9% during the same period last year.

Similarly, exports of engineering goods grew at 9.8% in FY25 till October as compared with 4.5% during the same period last year. Exports of petroleum products contracted for two consecutive years and



that of ores and minerals, too contracted 12.2% during the seven months of this financial year.

Exports of agricultural and allied products remain flat and that of textiles grew by just 2.4% during the seven months of this financial year after contracting by 2.4% during the same period last year.
