MUMBAI 3RD-BIGGEST DATA CENTRE MKT IN ASIA-PACIFIC: KNIGHT FRANK

New Delhi, 22 May

Mumbai with a total capacity of 2,337 megawatt (Mw) has been ranked third on the list of top data centre markets in the Asia–Pacific region. Shanghai was on the top with a 2,692 Mw capacity, followed by Tokyo (2,575 MW capacity), according to a report by Knight Frank, a real estate consultant.

Mumbai's live capacity (operational capacity) stood at 270 Mw (11.55 per cent of total capacity). Over half of the total capacity of the city is in the early stage at 1,272 Mw.

Sydney with a total capacity of 1,746 MW stood at fourth position in the list, followed by Seoul (1,354 MW) at fifth and Singapore (1,227 MW) at sixth position.

Meanwhile, with a total capacity of 989 MW, Hong Kong was ranked at 7th position.

Bangkok which stood at 8th position with a total capacity of 269 MW also saw an increase of nearly 30 percent since the beginning of the year.
