Salcomp to make EV chargers for India

POSITIONING ITSELF TO become a significant player in India, Finland-based Salcomp, the largest contract manufacturer of chargers and adaptors for smartphones, including iPhones, on Thursday announced that it will make chargers for electric two-wheeler and three-wheelers.

Though the company had earlier shipped chargers for four-wheelers from its Chennai plant to the US, this is the first time it has decided to take a serious plunge into making chargers for Indian market. It will also look at servicing the global markets at a later stage.

In a bid to get designs for the chargers, the company has partnered with Flowtrik, an IIT Madras Incubated startup. Salcompwill be the exclusive manufacturing (sourcing) and business development partner for Flowtrik, which designs chargers for advanced batteries such as Li-ion, advanced lead acid and other alternate batteries used in EVs.

Sasikumar Gendham, MD, Salcomp India, said, "Salcomp aims to play a significant role in the EV ecosystem not only for India, but also rest of the world. This partnership with Flowtrik will augment us to be a significant player in the EV space."

Flowtrik will also continue to develop new charger products as per market requirements in consultation with Salcomp.
