

# Bajaj wheels in Pulsar P150 at ₹1.2 lakh

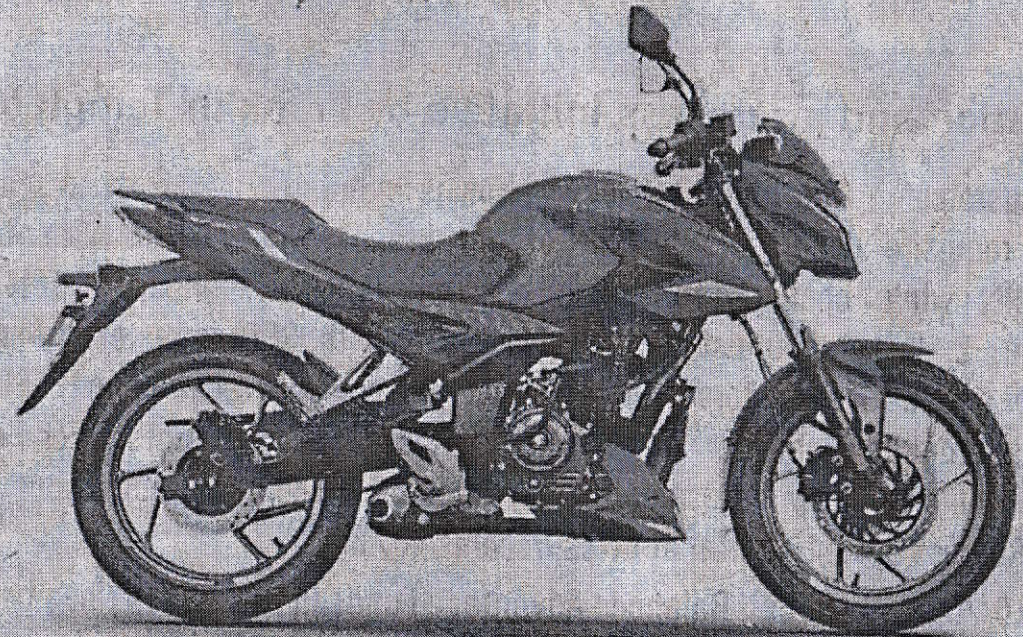

Bajaj Auto on Tuesday launched its new Pulsar P150 in the country. The bike is introduced in two versions – single-disc (single seat) and twin-disc (split seat).

The new Pulsar P150 is priced at ₹1,19,757 (ex-showroom New Delhi) and ₹1,19,565 (ex-showroom Kolkata) for the twin-disc variant, and ₹1,16,755 (ex-showroom New Delhi) and ₹1,16,563 (ex-showroom Kolkata) for single-disc variant.

After the 250cc (N250 and F250) and 160cc (N160) versions, this is Pulsar's third of-



fering. The bike is equipped with a new mono-shock rear suspension and an underbelly exhaust that is positioned near the bike's centre of gravity.

There is also a 10-kg re-

duction in weight (for the twin-disc variant), which means an 11 per cent increase in the power-to-weight ratio, thus enhancing the sporty credentials of the bike even further.
