

Tata Motors seeks PLI sops for Tiago EV

Mumbai, 26 July

Tata Motors, the market leader in electric four-wheeler space, has sought incentives for its Tiago EV under the government's production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme, Group Chief Financial Officer P B Balaji said on Tuesday.

The Mumbai-headquartered firm has applied for all variants of the Tiago, which recently hit a sales milestone

of 10,000 units.

"The Automotive Research Association of India certification is done. We are now in the process of filing paperwork and we expect to get an approval from the government in the next one or two months," Balaji told reporters.

Original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) have to take an eligibility certificate from the association, a testing agency under the Ministry of Heavy Industries, to claim incentives under the PLI scheme that was launched to promote domestic production.

Mahindra and Mahindra had recently received an eligibility certificate from the association for its electric three-wheeler.
