

Toyota Kirloskar Motor drives in all-new Innova HyCross

MORE TO CHOOSE FROM. Options will include 5 hybrid and 2 gasoline models

Toyota Kirloskar Motor on Friday launched the new Toyota Innova HyCross, a self-charging strong hybrid electric vehicle.

The company did not reveal the price of the new HyCross. The bookings have started, and the deliveries will begin in mid-January. The vehicle options will include five hybrid and two gasoline models. The new Innova HyCross will have a fuel efficiency of 21.1 km and deliver a maximum power output of 137 kW (186 PS). The gasoline version comes with a TNGA 2.0 litre engine delivering an output of 128 kW.

SAFETY FEATURES

The car is equipped with safety features including cruise control, rear cross-traffic alert, blind spot mon-

itor, pre-collision system, electronic parking brake, and anti-lock braking system with electronic brake force distribution. "The self-charging, strong hybrid electric vehicle is loaded with features to meet the aspira-

tions of Indian customers," said Hideki Mizuma, Chief Engineer, Innova, Toyota.

INNOVA CRYSTA DIESEL

On the suspension of taking orders for diesel Innova Crysta, the company said it

was a temporary measure. "It has been stopped because of the high waiting period. We will not be discontinuing the vehicle," said Vikram Kirloskar, Vice-Chairman, Toyota Kirloskar Motor.
